church government was restored throughout the country, and the Lancashire assemblies of divines and religious *classis* were all dissolved.

The year after the King's return, an act of uniformity was carried through parliament, by the operation of which no fewer than two thousand clergymen were ejected or silenced in England and Wales. The first consequence of this act was to subject to extreme privations the clergy who could not conscientiously conform to the obligations it imposed; and the second to raise up Dissenting Meeting-houses in all the principal towns of the kingdom. The objectionable clauses were partly of a religious and partly of a secular nature. The first required re-ordination where the ceremony had not already been performed by a bishop—subscription to every thing contained in the book of common prayer—canonical obedience—and abjuration of the solemn league and covenant; and the political obligation required the clergymen to swear, “that it

was not lawful, on any pretence whatsoever, to take up arms against the King.* This impolitic law came into force on St. Bartholomew's day, August 24th, 1662, and the number of ejected and silenced ministers in the churches and chapels of Lancashire alone amounted to sixty-seven, of whom a list is subjoined:—
