on a charge of bribery, proved against some of his supporters. Sir John Wm. Ramsden, Bart., is lord of the *Manor of Huddersfield*, and owns nearly all the land and building sites in and near the town. J. C. Fenton, Esq., is steward of the Manor Courts.

HUDDERSFIELD UNION, formed in 1837, under the *New Poor Law*, comprises the four parishes of Huddersfield, Almondbury, Kirkburton, and Kirkheaton, which include 33 townships, which increased their population from 88,772 in 1831, to 108,019 souls in 1841, and to 123,843 in 1851. The *Board of Guardians* meet at the Board Room, in Albion street, and consist of 37 persons, of whom five are elected yearly for Huddersfield, and one for each of the other townships. The five old *Workhouses at Huddersfield, Almondbury, Golcar, Honley, and Kirkheaton*, are still used by this populous union, and have room for 244 inmates. The union expended in supporting the poor and the payment of salaries, &c., £21,614 in 1843, and £15,431 in 1851, exclusive of county rates. Mr. C. S. Floyd is the *union clerk and superintendent registrar*; and the following are the *relieving officers*:—Bj. Whitley for *Huddersfield District*; Abm. Meller, for *Holmfirth District*; Stephen Washington for *Kirkburton District*; and Thos. Wood for *Golcar District*. The masters and matrons of the *Workhouses* are—Mr. J. Berry and Mrs. Broadley, at *Huddersfield*; Mr. J. Dean, at *Almondbury*; Mr. J. Haigh, at *Golcar*; Mrs. Brittlebank, at *Honley*; and Mrs. Mottershead, at *Kirkheaton*. Mr. J. Frost is the *vagrant officer, &c.*, and Mr. B. Taylor, *assistant overseer*, for Huddersfield township. Messrs. John Cocking, jun., of Huddersfield, and Joseph Cuttall, of Holmfirth, are *registrars of marriages*; and Mr. John Brook is *registrar of births and deaths* for Huddersfield District.

IMPROVEMENT ACTS, &c.—An act for lighting, watching, cleansing, and improving the town of Huddersfield, was obtained in 1820, under which the commissioners effected such improvements as their limited powers allowed; but these were greatly inadequate to the wants of this rapidly increasing town. A new *Improvement Act* was obtained in 1848, and a *Burial Ground Act* in 1852. The former act vests with the Commissioners extensive powers for improving the sanitary condition of the town, by a complete system of *sewerage*; by widening inconvenient thoroughfares; by more effectually lighting, cleansing, and paving the streets, &c.; by removing and preventing nuisances; and by maintaining an efficient police. Under the *Burial Ground Act* they are about to open a large *Cemetery* in the suburbs. There are 21 *Commissioners* elected by the ratepayers, and three appointed by the Lord of the Manor. The *improvements* now in progress and in contemplation will cost upwards of £50,000, and the Commissioners are empowered to borrow money, to be repaid by annual instalments in thirty years, by rates levied on the inhabitants. The owners of property may also claim the same terms, or pay at once for the private drainage and other work done for them by the Commissioners, whose expenditure in the year ending April 30th, 1852, was £13,644; and in the following year, £14,828. The present COMMISSIONERS are Messrs. Joseph Brook, (chairman,) John Sutcliffe, Jermh. Riley, T. B. Crosland, Thos. Mallinson, Edm. Eastwood, Wm. Moore, Jas. Booth, Jere Kaye, Thos. Firth, John Brook, Thos. Haley, Luke Swallow, Thos. Varley, Jph. Webb, John Firth, James North, Samuel Routledge, Mdk. Greenwood, Jph. Turner, and John Labrey. Mr. T. M. Clough, is their *clerk*; James Armytage, *surveyor*; Joshua Hobson, *clerk to the board of works*; John Sykes, *assistant surveyor*; J. S. Hirst, *rate collector*; and John Jarratt, *inspector of nuisances, &c.* The Commissioners have also the regulation of Hackney Coaches and Lodging Houses; and the execution of the *Burial Ground Act*, under which they have borrowed

LOCKWOOD is a large and well built village, pleasantly seated in the vale of the Holme, near its confluence with the other branch of the river Colne, 1 mile south of Huddersfield. Its commodious *Spa Baths*, built in 1827, are only half a mile from Huddersfield, as noticed at p. 598. Lockwood Valley is crossed by a stupendous *Railway Viaduct* of 36 arches, resting on lofty stone piers. The township of Lockwood contains 5556 inhabitants, and 1670 acres. The Church, (St. Emanuel) was built by Government, and finished in 1839, at the cost of £3000. The perpetual curacy, valued at £150, is in the gift of the Vicar of Almondbury. The Baptists and Wesleyans have chapels here; and in the village is a large school, built by subscription, in 1821.

**MARSDEN**, in the Honour of Pontefract, is a large village, township, and chapelry, on the river Colne, adjoining the dells and lofty hills of Saddleworth, 7 miles S.W. of Huddersfield. It comprises 8670 acres, and has 2865 inhabitants, of whom 625 are in *Huddersfield parish*, and the rest in *Almondbury parish*. The village lies in a deep valley, near the *Huddersfield Canal Tunnel*, which passes three miles under a mountainous ridge; and along the side of which is a large tunnel on the *Huddersfield and Manchester Railway*. Three fairs are held here on April 25th, July 10th, and Sept. 25th. In 1812, Mr. Wm. Hersfall, of Marsden, was murdered here by the Luddites. The *Church* (St. Bartholomew) is a coracy, valued at £174, in the gift of the vicar of Almondbury. Here is an old Independent Chapel; and a *Mechanics' Institution*, established in 1842.

OVENDEN, a large straggling village, in a pleasant vale,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mile N. by W. of Halifax, has in its township 12,738 inhabitants, and the following villages and hamlets, the largest of which are ILLINGWORTH and MIXENDEN, nearly 3 miles N.N.W.; Holdsworth,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles N.; *Wheatley*,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mile N.W.; Bradshaw, 4 miles N.; and *Pellon*, 1 mile W.N.W. of Halifax. *Illingworth Church* (St. Mary) is on a bleak elevation, and was rebuilt in 1777. It is a curacy, valued at £140. *St. John's Church*, at Bradshaw, was built in 1838 by government, except £800 given by the late Mrs. Eliz. Wadsworth, who built a national school here. The Vicar is patron of both curacies, and the latter is valued at £150. *Mount Pellon Church* is noticed at page 550, and its district includes part of this township. The *Wesleyans* have chapels at Ovenden, Illingworth Moor, and Mount Tabor; the *N. C. Methodists* have one at

Upper Brockholes; the *Primitives* have one in Bradshaw lane; and the *Independents* have chapels at Ovenden Moor side and Mixenden. The poor have about £30 a year from several benefactions. There is a *Mechanics' Institution* and school at Mixenden.

## RAILWAY, &amp;c.

SOWERBY, a large village in the vale of the Calder, 4 miles S.W. of Halifax, has its township 7905 inhabitants, and the undermentioned hamlets, &c., as well as parts of the villages of Sowerby-Bridge and Mytholmroyd. *Haugh-end* was the birth-place of *Dr. Tillotson*, Archbishop of Canterbury. ST. PETER'S CHURCH is a large Gothic fabric, erected in 1762, when the *old chapel of ease* was taken down, and part of it removed to Field House, where it forms an ornamental ruin. The curacy, valued at £160, is the gift of the Vicar of Halifax. ST. GEORGE'S CHURCH has 604 sittings, and was erected, with a parsonage house, in 1839-'40, at the cost of about £2700, raised by subscription. The curacy, valued at £150, is in the gift of the Vicar. *St. Mary's Church* is a curacy, valued at £150, in the alternate patronage of the Crown and the Bishop of Ripon. Besides the three churches there are in the township *six chapels*, viz., two belonging to the Independents; two to the Wesleyans; and one each to the Baptists and N. C. Methodists. The *Free School* has £16 a year for twelve free scholars; and the poor have about £110 yearly from several benefactions. Here also are two *National Schools*, one built in 1845, at the cost of £657.
